Contestant Eligibility

1. Miss Wild West Stampede contestant must not be less than 17 years old and no older than 23 years old as of the date of the Saturday rodeo performance.
2. May not be, or have previously been, married, and/or pregnant, and never convicted of a crime. If any of this should occur during the Queen's reign, she will forfeit her title and all prizes.
3. Must execute all consents and/or waivers of liability presented prior to competition.
4. Live within Placer, Nevada, Yuba, Sutter, El Dorado or Sacramento County, or other surrounding counties.
5. A contestant must agree to abide by all pageant rules. Failure to do so could result in disqualification.

Rules and Regulations

1. Applicants must conduct themselves in a lady-like-manner and portray high moral standards. Applicants will not be permitted to drink alcoholic beverages, smoke or use foul language at any time during the pageant, rodeo week, or when representing the Wild West Stampede.
2. Applicants must supply one high quality 8 x 10 headshot photo. The photo can be black and white or color, (color is preferred) with western attire and a hat. The photos will be used for judging and publicity and will not be returned.
3. The Queen agrees to make a reasonable number of appearances throughout the year, including community events as well as local rodeos, (i.e., Truckee, Salinas, Marysville, Livermore, Red Bluff, Folsom, Hayward, and Reno) and will be required to sign a contract. Queens are encouraged to participate in community service to promote rodeo.

Judging Procedures

This year's Miss Wild West Stampede will be an appointed position. Applications will be taken and reviewed by a Selection Committee. At a date to be determined, applicants will be asked to ride a modified stock pattern on the horse they will be using for rodeo appearances, make a Queen run and a flag run. There will be no horsemanship practices beforehand as in previous years. On the same date, the Selection Committee will interview each applicant separately and will be looking for their knowledge of rodeo, equine and the Wild West Stampede; judge their poise, personality, and speaking ability as well as appearance.
